What to expect from the respiratory clinics

In order to provide effective primary care to Corona Virus symptomatic patients in a way that protects other patients and our staff from infection, we have set up a special respiratory clinic at Conygre Road.

Patients who have Corona Virus symptoms and need to see a clinician, will be asked to attend Conygre Road Medical Centre (BS34 7DA).

Prior to attending, we will complete a telephone assessment to record all relevant history details.

We will text you with a mobile number and ask that you text that number when you arrive in the car park at Conygre Road Medical Centre.

A clinician wearing protective clothing will collect you from the car park and escort you into the building via the side entrance.

We will ask you to disinfect your hands and put on a surgical mask.

You will be examined and treated by a clinician wearing protective clothing that will include a face mask, apron and gloves and could include eye protection.

At the end of the consultation, your face mask will be put in a clinical waste bag and we will disinfect your hands again as you leave the building.
